

Wednesday B- Walks Programme

- Meet on Wednesdays at Eastham Library car park at 9.00am. Eastham Library is located at the junction of Eastham Rake and Mill Park Drive (opposite Tesco), just off the A41. Approaching via M53, exit at junction 5 and take first exit at roundabout on to A41. Turn left at first Traffic Lights then left at mini roundabout. Car park on immediate left. Departure by 9.15am.
- Walkers wishing to go directly to a venue MUST contact the leader beforehand.
- There is a charge of 50p per person per walk. Or alternatively, a 'season ticket' may be purchased for £5. All leaders are exempt from these charges.
- For most walks, a minibus is used to reach the walking destination. A charge (usually between £5-£7) is made to cover running costs. When the minibus is unavailable or if there are more than 13 people on the walk, use of participants' vehicles will be required, with costs shared appropriately. Walk leaders are required to provide travel directions to the start point, and their mobile phone number to any other drivers.
- The walk will fall within the range of 11 - 14 points. The points system is based on a combination of mileage (1 point per mile) and ascent (1 point per 500ft climbed).
- New walkers or those who have not walked for some time should always phone the leader of the walk beforehand to ascertain the distance and height involved to assess whether the walk is suitable for them.

- Walks to be confined within approx. 50 miles of Arroe Park, but preferably beyond the 30 miles from Arroe Park boundary used by the midweek 'C' rambles. Locations around the 50-mile perimeter include Bangor, Blaenau Ffestiniog, Bala Lake, Welshpool, Shrewsbury, Stone, Buxton, Glossop, Holmfirth, Hebden Bridge, Colne, Clitheroe and Lancaster. The aim should be to commence walking at 10:30am and finish no later than 4:30pm.
- In the event of inclement weather, it may be necessary to cancel a walk. The designated leader should always attend at the advertised time to make this decision.
- Non-members are welcome for two walks after which they are expected to join the Ramblers.

- On the walks, please remember to keep behind the leader always. On minor roads or lanes, the leader should direct the party to walk in single file, close to the right-hand side (where possible). On approach of vehicles everybody should be on the SAME side of the road.
