A Walk - Keith Morris

Points range 18-23

Starting from CP N to Low Sweden Bridge and on to Hart Crag. Return SE over Red Screens then S over Snarker Pike, briefly joining the Struggle, then FPs and lanes into Ambleside. Good or reasonable paths throughout.

Distance: 19.5 Km (12 mls) Ascent: 1,200 m (3,900 ft)

Walk Points: 20

B Plus Walk – Martin Hayward

Points range 14-18

From Ambleside, we start a steady climb up the Kirkstone Road and then footpaths, up to Red Screens, passing Flesh Crag and Raven Crag. We descend to the Scandale pass via Middle Dodd and then up to Scandale Head to make the ridge. We follow this ridge back to Ambleside passing both High and Low Pike. Great views of the area, particularly the Kirkstone Pass (photos on Facebook). Mostly good paths.

Distance: 16 Km (10mls) Ascent:1,013m (3,324ft)

Starting from Ambleside we pass the Parish Church and go through Rothay Park and climb to Todd Crag. (View Point of Windermere) . We skirt round Loughrigg fell and follow a path past Loughrigg Tarn. (coffee stop) . A short road walk brings us to Loughrigg Terrace with wonderful views of Grasmere and RYDALMERE Water. (For the very energetic there is the option to ascend Ewe Crag whilst the rest of us have another coffee break.) We descend to cross between these two lakes and stop for lunch at the picnic site. There is a swim option here and 75cm of water is guaranteed . We follow a path to the coffin trail , through RYDALMERE Hall gardens and back to Ambleside

Distance: 12.8 Km: (8 mls) Ascent: 274 m (900 ft)

Points range 5-7

Alighting at Brockhole Visitor Centre on the A591 approx 2.5 miles from Ambleside (NY390012), we begin this linear walk by taking the footpath beside the A591 and start our ascent on an ancient track known as Wain Lane towards Town End. We then follow Robin Lane passing by farmland, High Skelgyll and Skelgyll Wood taking in the Lake view at Jenkin's Crag along the way before continuing into Ambleside. Great views along the way.

Distance: 9 Km (5.5 mls) Ascent: 182 m (600 ft)

Walk Points: 6.5
