Standing Arrangements

- The meeting point will vary depending on the location of the walks. But there will always be one on Wirral for those wishing to car share. Suggested places include, Eastham Library (whilst still free), Tudor Rose, or possibly Bidston Railway Car Park. For details, check the email sent out, or contact Sue Martin on 07880 535401.
- Walkers wishing to go directly to a venue **MUST** contact the leader beforehand.
- For those car sharing, the cost will be 10p a mile so costs between £8 - £10
- The walk will fall within the range of 11 – 14 points. The points system is based on a combination of mileage (1 point per mile) and ascent (1 point per 500ft climbed).
- New walkers or those who have not walked for some time should always phone the leader of the walk beforehand to ascertain the distance and height involved to assess whether or not the walk is suitable for them.
- Walks to be confined within approx. 50 miles of Arrowe Park, but preferably beyond the 30 miles from Arrowe Park boundary used by the midweek "C" rambles. Locations around the 50 mile perimeter include Bangor, Blaenau Ffestiniog, Bala Lake, Welshpool, Shrewsbury, Stone, Buxton, Glossop, Holmfirth, Hebden Bridge, Colne, Clitheroe and Lancaster. The aim should be to commence walking at 10.30am and finish no later than 4.30pm.
- In the event of inclement weather it may be necessary to cancel a walk. Please keep a look out for any emails sent on the Tuesday before the walk.
- Non-members are welcome for three walks after which they are expected to join The Ramblers.
- For details of individual walks please contact the leader concerned. For other information please contact the walks organizer, Sue Martin, on 07880 535401.
- On the walks, please remember to keep behind the leader at all times. On minor roads or lanes, the leader should direct the party to walk in single file, close to the right-hand side (where possible). On approach of vehicles everybody should be on the **SAME** side of the road.
