A Walk - Keith Morris

Rucksacks on Coach please

Points range 18-23

Starting from A592 (GR399 199) N to Aira Force, W crossing A5091 (*caution*) and climbing steadily beneath Watermillock Common before climbing more steeply and then contouring above Glencoyne to the valley head. Go E over White Stones and Stybarrow Dodd before heading S over Raise, Whiteside to Helvellyn. Subject to conditions we return E via Swirl Edge (*significant scrambling*), Hole in the Wall and Birklowe Moor, Rattlebeck Bridge and to Glenridding CP. The route is almost entirely on paths and *requires some scrambling*, particularly on the descent of Swirl Edge. Vertiginous sections on narrow path above Glencoyne and descent of Swirl Edge.

Distance: 19.5Km (12 mls)

Ascent: 1,200 m (3,950 ft)

Walk Points: 20

B Plus Walk – Peter O'

Points range 14-18

Starting from Glenridding we head W along Greenside Road into the Common and climb above Red Screes to Whiteside Bank. We then head N to Raise for magnificent views. We start our descent via Sticks Pass to a Tip. Here we continue E down Bleabank Side. We enter the lovely Glencoyne Valley passing by the interestingly named "Seldom Seen". Then it's back to Glenridding via the lake shore. A slightly less travelled route.

Distance: 16 kms (10miles).

Ascent: 780m (2560ft).

Walk Points: 15

B Minus Walk – Paul K

Points range 11-14

From Glenridding we follow the beck W then ascend footpaths S via hostel, Lanty's Tarn and Brownend Plantation. We turn SW to follow north side of beautiful Grisedale and make a pebbly ascent to Grisedale Tarn. Retracting our steps to Grisedale we follow the southside back NE. We head N past Lanty's Tarn and West Side to Glenridding. Muddy in places and slippery stones if wet. Gaiters and poles recommended.

Distance 8.5mls (13.6km)

Ascent 2000ft (600m)

Points 12.5

C Walk – Pam McEwan

Points range 7-11

Take the road to Patterdale. Head E to pick up Coast to Coast path in Grizedale Valley crossing at sheepfold. Follow N side of Grizedale Beck and cross into Glenridding Valley head E to cross over the weir then turn W to head back to the village. Mostly good paths with some boggy bits. Great scenery!

Distance 14.5 km (9 miles)

Ascent 244 m (800 ft)

Walk Points: 10.5

D Walk- Barbra Noden

Rucksacks on Coach please

Points range 5-7

Starting from Aira Force cafe and free toilets (waterfall view only available on photo) we follow Ullswater Way by the lake S (short busy road section). Before the village we cross the road and ascend gently to the Glenridding valley. Turning down before the disused mine and Youth Hostel we cross the beck and return to the village. A few stiles but great views of the lake and surrounding mountains. Terrain generally good.

Distance: 8km (5 miles)

Ascent: 152m (500ft)

Walk Points: 6
